There will be guided tours in Greek and English by the excavator of the site, former Curator of Antiquities Dr. Despina Pilides .

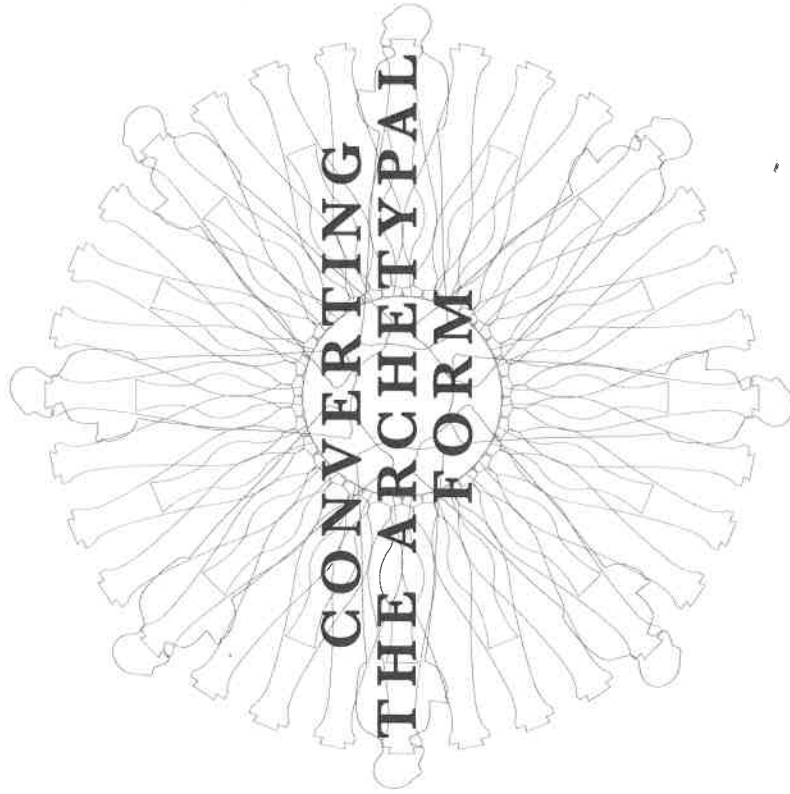
